The extended abstracts of maximum 1000 words (restricted to 3 pages including figures, tables) may be submitted in the enclosed format **on or before April 28, 2017** by 5 pm. Late submissions will not be considered.

The entries will be shortlisted and authors of those will be invited for a presentation before an expert panel on **May 8, 2017**.

The best three projects will be awarded prizes and will be given a chance to present their project in front of an august audience during National Technology Day-2017, on **11th May 2017**. Some more projects with promising contributions will be selected and these projects will also be given a platform through poster /oral presentation on May 11, 2017. Citations/Certificates will be presented to the successful projects on the National Technology Day-2017.
