#### II. Original Documents to be brought by the candidates at the time of admission

1. Provisional allotment letter.
2. Rank Card NIMCET-2018.
3. Admit card of NIMCET-2018.
4. Aadhaar Card
5. Proof of Date of Birth (SSLC or equivalent Certificate).
6. Intermediate or 10+2 Class Marks sheet
7. Intermediate or 10+2 Pass Certificate
8. Qualifying Degree - Marks Statements of all semesters/years.
9. Qualifying Degree - Provisional/Degree Certificate
10. *Candidates who are appearing for their final examination and are awaiting results should produce all original mark lists up to and including pre-final semester/pre-final Year. **Such candidates will be considered for provisional admission provided they will be able to submit the original/provisional degree certificate and final mark list (satisfying the eligibility criteria) by 15<sup>th</sup> September 2018.** They have to produce a **certificate from the Head of the Institution** stating that he/she has appeared for the final semester/year examination of the qualifying degree.*
11. Diploma certificate and mark sheets in case of lateral entry candidates.
12. Conduct/Character certificate from the Head of the Institution/ Organization last attended/working, issued within last six months.
13. Caste Certificate, in the case of SC/ST candidate, from a competent authority (not below the rank of Tahsildar).
14. Community Certificate, in the case of OBC-NCL candidate, from a competent authority (not below the rank of Tahsildar) indicating the status regarding Creamy Layer issued on or after **1<sup>st</sup> April, 2018**.
15. Migration/Transfer/Leaving Certificate from the institution last attended.
16. Certificate from the **Medical Board of Govt. Medical Colleges/Dist. Head Quarters Hospitals**, in the case of Physically Handicapped candidates.
17. One passport size photograph and one stamp size photograph.
18. One set of self-attested copy of the above certificates (Sl. No. 4-16) whichever is applicable for you.

Candidates are advised to keep sufficient number of attested copies of mark lists and other certificates for their future use, if any, since all the original certificates submitted to NIT Calicut at the time of admission will be retained in the Institute till the admission process is over.

If any certificate is in a language other than English/Hindi, an English version of that certificate attested by the Gazetted Officer should be produced compulsorily.

### III. Institute Fee to be paid at the time of admission

At the time of admission, the candidate needs to pay the following amount with regard to the category of the candidate and the round in which allotment is accepted:

Payment has to be made through **State Bank Collect** (online) using **Net Banking / Credit Card/ SBI Challan (by cash) after reporting at Bhaskara Hall, NIT Calicut.**

If a candidate does not report for admission during the specified date and time, his/her candidature for admission will stand cancelled. Requests for any change of date or time of admission or request for more time to remit the fee or to produce the required documents will not be entertained.

**Hostel facilities:** Hostel accommodation is subjected to availability of rooms.

Hostel fee at the time of admission is Rs. **15,000/-** for all students.

The DD for hostel fee should be drawn in favour of: **“The Chief Warden, NITC Hostels”** payable at **State Bank of India, NIT Calicut Branch (Code No. 2207).**

### IV. Other Information

#### Location of the Institute

National Institute of Technology Calicut (NITC) is located in a campus near Chathamangalam, about 22 km North East of Calicut City in Kerala State. The Campus extends for a length of about 1.5 km along the Kunnamangalam – Mukkam Road and covers an area of approximately 120 hectares in a picturesque landscape at the foothills of the Western Ghats. The Institute is connected with Calicut City by Private buses starting from Corporation Bus Station, Palayam (near Calicut Railway Station) and KSRTC buses starting from KSRTC Bus Stand. The nearest airport is at Karipur near Calicut, which is 35 km from the Institute.
