**NOTICE**

The meeting of Deans and HoDs held on 15-January-2022 discussed the covid situation prevailing in the country and associated measures suggested by the District health authorities, and arrived at the following decisions.

1. All academic activities for students in all UG and PG programs including examinations and presentations shall be conducted through online mode.
2. PG students across all programs will be permitted to leave the hostels if they wish to do so. They will not be required to sign in the attendance register kept in the Departments. They will continue to perform the teaching assistantship duties through online.
3. All academic activities of Ph.D students admitted in 2021-22 academic year will happen through online mode. However, admission procedures for 2021-22 winter session will be as per the guidelines issued by Chairperson of the PG admissions.
4. For all Ph.D. students except the 2021-22 admissions, the current status will be continued. However they should strictly follow the covid protocols in the laboratories. Departments may introduce additional guidelines if necessary to ensure the safety of students and staff.
5. All UG students, except those who are given permission to stay in the hostels due to reasons such as connectivity issues, selected for UG innovative project funding, representing the Institute in National/International competitions, and attending GATE examination with "Kozhikode" as the centre, have to vacate the hostels as per the schedule to be published by the Chief Warden.
6. All pending laboratory sessions for the B.Tech final year students will be completed by the respective departments latest by Tuesday, 18-January 2022. They have to vacate the campus on or before 21-January-2022, as informed in the notice from this office dated

10-January. Students who are in need of experimental facilities for completing their B.Tech project will be permitted only in the most demanding situations. Such exceptions are to be recommended by the respective HoDs only sparingly and after full conviction. HoDs shall forward these requests to Chief Warden directly with due recommendation.

7. All students are required to strictly follow the covid protocols in the campus. Students who are permitted to stay in the hostels have to abide by the rules prescribed by the Chief Warden from time to time.
