NOTICE

Ref: NITC Hostels notice dated 16-01-2022

In partial modification of the notice cited above, the Council of Wardens has resolved to implement the following with effect from 24-01-2022.

- All those students who have requested to stay back, can stay in hostels until further orders, if their request is recommended by the concerned department and approved by the competent authority of NITC Hostels.
- All inmates must follow the COVID protocols strictly. Failure to do so will attract disciplinary action including permanent expulsion from hostels.
- Connecting personal network devices like Wi-Fi routers, to Institute's network and misuse of Institute's network facility for non-academic purposes will attract disciplinary action including permanent expulsion from hostels.
- All outdoor activities such as sports & games and social gatherings are banned until further orders.
- UG and PG students having fabrication/laboratory/experimental works and all PhD scholars are permitted to go to laboratories subject to guidelines, if any published by the concerned departments.
- Inmates will be permitted to go out of NITC campus for academic purposes only. Permission will be granted on a case-to-case basis, if strongly recommended by Faculty Advisor/Guide/Programme Coordinator.
- Any inmate developing COVID symptoms must inform the Hostel authorities and get tested immediately.
- Any inmate, tested positive for COVID-19 will be placed under quarantine and tested as per the directives from Health Department. They may opt for paid quarantine in Hostel or avail the free quarantine facility at CFLTC offered by the Health Department.
- All primary contacts will be placed under quarantine and tested as per the directives from Health Department.
- Quarantine charges of Rs. 1500/- and RTPCR test charges will be included in the mess bill, if an inmate is placed under quarantine in Hostel.
