## Minutes of the DCC Meeting on 5th June 2017 (Monday)

Venue: CSE 202

Time: 11.00 am

The meeting started at 11.00 am. Dr. Saidalavy Kalady, HOD, CSED welcomed the members to the DCC meeting. The Agenda of the meeting was to discuss the rules and regulations circulated. DCC considered the suggestions and ordinances and regulations circulated and made the following recommendations.

## Suggestions/Proposal

- 1. Yes. DCC agrees to the suggestion that attendance grade may be removed.
- 2. Yes. DCC feels that proposed suggestion for consolidating attendance is beneficial for the students/faculty.
- 3. No.
- 4. Yes. DCC recommends that faculty may be given freedom to conduct make up exam for T1 and T2, if permitted by rules. DCC recommends that there will be no make up for end semester exams and those students who need end semester make up can write it along with supplementary exam in even semester. DCC proposes that midterm exam pattern be changed to have only one mandatory midterm exam per semester.
- 5. No. DCC feels that R grade should continue.
- 6. In line with the suggestion of committee to take off Tathva and Ragam condonation, DCC recommends removal of medical condonation by setting attendaence requirement to 60%. DCC observed that in the latest rules and regulations approved by NIT Trichy gives flexibility to the faculty to insist on attendance required for a particular course as in Rule B.9
- "The course plan will outline the attendance requiremnts expected of a student to make him/her eligible to earn the credits of the particular course. Students who have not satisfied the attendance requirements of the course shall be awarded a 'V' grade for the course."
- 7. No. DCC feels that current practice of granting permission for Make-up examination is to be continued.

## Ordinances&Regulations for B.Tech and B.Arch Programmes at NIT Calicut

- 1. In R 2.7 DCC recommends removal of "based on the requirement/pre-registration data".
- 2. In R 3.1 DCC recommends removal of paragraph 4 and 5 from the regulations.

- 3. In R 4.5 DCC recommends removal of point (iii).
- 4. R6.5 may be amended to have a uniform policy for crediting PG course as minimum CGPA of 7.5
- 5. DCC proposes that R.14 may be amended to have a single mid term test instead of minimum two tests.
- 6. In R16 DCC recommends the change from "(normally between 40-60%)" to "appropriate weight as approved by the class committee.
- 7. In R18.2 DCC recommends the deletion of paragraph 2 about addition of soft copy of seminar report to digital library.
- 8. In R19.2 DCC proposes that the number of days to convene the class committee to be increased to 10 working days.
- 9. Regarding R27.1 DCC is of the opinion that probation be eliminated by radical measures
