The mandate of the Institute is to provide higher technical education and conduct research in the various branches of Engineering, Science, Technology, Management and Education and offers bachelors, masters and doctoral degree programs. With its proactive collaborations with a multitude of research organizations, academic institutions and industries, the institute is engaged in a wide spectrum of activities covering research and development, industrial consultancy, continuing education and faculty & staff development.

LOCATION

Set in a picturesque landscape at the foothills of the Western Ghats, NIT Calicut is located about 22 kilometres north-east of Calicut city in the state of Kerala, India. It stretches over a length of about 1.5 kilometres along the Calicut-Mukkam road, extending over an area of approximately 120 hectares. The nearest Airport is Calicut which is about 45 km. away from the Campus.

INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

The Department of Education, NIT Calicut is running a 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP). The Institute invites applications from qualified individuals with good academic backgrounds to serve as temporary faculty (part time) in the disciplines of Physical Science, Hindi and Malayalam for handling the academic teaching load in the Winter semester 2024-25. Retired people from higher educational Institutions/Colleges with exceptionally good academic backgrounds also may apply (Maximum Age: 65 years). This engagement will be purely on a temporary basis and will not lead to any claim for any post that may arise in the future. Degrees from recognized Universities/Institutions will only be accepted. The candidates shall have first class both at UG and PG Level (60% or 6.5/10 CGPA, if not mentioned in the certificate). For SC/ST candidates, 55% marks (CGPA 6/10) both at UG and PG Level. **Those who have served the institute as Adhoc faculty/Temporary faculty for about 5 semesters are not eligible to apply.**

Applications in the specified format (available at www.nitc.ac.in) with all relevant documents sent by e-mail to the concerned Chairperson of the Centre will only be considered. Applicants under the General and OBC category have to pay a non-refundable fee of Rs. 1000/- per application, and applicants under SC, ST, and EWS category have to pay a non-refundable fee of Rs. 500/- per application. Application fees have to be paid through “SBI Collect”. PwD candidates are exempted from fee payment.

- **The last date for online application is 27-12-2024.**
- Reservations are applicable as per the Govt. of India norms.

- No request for a change of interview schedule shall be entertained.
- No TA/DA shall be payable, and the candidates are required to make necessary boarding and lodging arrangements on their own.
- **Selected candidates will be informed by e-mail/mobile, and they are expected to join immediately.**
- The candidates are required to attach the following documents along with the application.
