**Minutes of the DCC Meeting on 26<sup>th</sup> October 2016 (Wednesday)**

Venue :CSE 202

Time : 12.20 pm

The meeting started at 12.20 pm. Dr. SaidalavyKalady, HOD, CSED welcomed the members to the DCC meeting. The Agenda of the meeting is given below:

1. Approval of the recommendations of the curriculum revision committee (please see file crcoct16.pdf). Additional point to discuss and suggest in the meeting: The maximum number of credits permitted for a course.
2. Identification of core courses for B.Tech CSE offered by the department (except first year courses). (Please see proposed courses in the file meetoct26.pdf) The following are changes proposed from the present curriculum:
  - a) Program Design course (and laboratory) has been re-introduced (as in the 2006 curriculum) in the third semester replacing the foundations of computing course and laboratory in the third semester.
  - b) Hardware laboratory and logic design laboratory has been combined to one laboratory course in the third semester.

Dr. Muralikrishnan briefed the details of the CRC meeting. DCC discussed the above matters

- 1) DCC suggested that Item No. 9 of CRC minutes may be restated as "Relative grading may be adopted by all the departments".
- 2) DCC supported the introduction of Lifescience course as a first year course.
- 3) DCC proposed to retain Introduction to profession course in the new curriculum after modification. The syllabus should be revised to make it more concrete and to avoid redundancy.
- 4) DCC recommended a branch specific curriculum for first year courses.
- 5) DCC suggested a separate grade card for audit courses and GIAN courses.
- 6) DCC proposed to take help/feedback from industry experts(all stake holders) in the syllabus revision process. Proper documentation of the entire process was also proposed by the DCC.
- 7) Dr. Vineeth Paleri explained the details of the credit calculations.
- 8) DCC decided to continue the discussion on 31-10-16(Monday), 12:15pm in CSE 201.
- 9) Item No.2 of the DCC agenda was discussed and DCC approved the core courses.
