**ANNOUNCEMENT:**

**INTEGRATED TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM (ITEP) B.SC.- B.ED.**  
**(SECONDARY LEVEL) FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-2026**

National Institute of Technology Calicut (NITC) is pleased to announce the admission to Four-Year Integrated Teacher Education Program (ITEP), B.Sc. - B.Ed. for the academic session 2025-2026. This innovative program, in compliance with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, aims to prepare highly qualified and multidisciplinary teachers for the Indian education system. The B.Sc. - B.Ed. integrated course offers a unique opportunity for aspiring educators to gain comprehensive knowledge in their chosen science discipline along with professional pedagogical skills, all within a four-year duration. B.Sc-B.Ed (Secondary level) being offered with Majors in three different disciplines namely Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. Options to exit with a three-year B.Sc degree in Physics, Chemistry or Mathematics depending on the choice of Major in the first semester itself is also available.

**B. Eligibility criteria :**

Candidates who have appeared NCET-2025 and have secured a valid score are eligible to apply for B.Sc. B.Ed. admission at NIT Calicut, provided they satisfy the following:

- The candidates must have passed or appeared for the first time in either 2023 or 2024 or 2025 for the XII Examinations or Intermediate with domain specific subjects as compulsory.
- Candidates must have secured at least 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent grades in class XII or Intermediate. The aggregate marks for SC, ST and PwD candidates should be at least 55%.
- To be eligible for a particular Major, it is mandatory that the candidate should have studied that particular subject in the class XII (10+2) or its equivalent and should have opted it as one of the domain specific subjects in NCET-2025 examination.

(eg: In order to become eligible for a Mathematics Major, the candidate should have completed class XII or its equivalent with Mathematics as one of the subjects and should have written Mathematics paper in NCET examination).

(d) The Candidate should chosen NIT, Calicut in the NCET 2025 application form.

(e) Proof of passing Class XII and having secured requisite marks must be submitted when applying. Original documents must be produced to NIT Calicut at the time of admission.

(f) Candidates should have been born on or after 01 October 2000. Five years of age relaxation is given to SC, ST, and PwD candidates, i.e., these candidates should have been born on or after October 1, 1995.

### D. Selection procedure:

i) The candidate has to pay a non-refundable amount of Rs. 1000/- for General, OBC-NCL, and Gen-EWS categories and Rs. 500/- for SC, ST and PwD categories as application fee.

ii) The candidates will be required to fill out the Online Application Form at <https://nitc.ac.in/itep> that will be launched soon (tentatively by first week of July).

iii) The online applications and uploaded documents will be scrutinized by the Admission Committee. Allotment will be carried out in order of merit of the total score or average percentile obtained in four subjects (Domain specific subject, English Language, General Test and Teaching Aptitude) in the National Common Entrance Test (NCET)-2025.

(iv) A unique rank list will be generated by NIT Calicut based on the above criteria.

(v) In case of a tie, the candidate older in age will be placed above the candidate who is younger in age. For those who are eligible for more than one Major, provisions will be made for the applicants for giving preference.

The Institute reserves the right to conduct any subsequent rounds of admission including spot rounds based on seat availability for registered candidates.

#### **E. Reservation and other policies:**

Category wise reservation rules will be followed as per Government of India guidelines prevailing at the time of admission. The Category (Unreserved/OBC-NCL/SC/ST/PwD/Economically Weaker Section (EWS)), once chosen by the applicant in his/her application form shall not be changed at a later stage. **OBC-NCL/EWS Certificate must have been issued on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2025.** No certificate issued before this date shall be acceptable. The certificates should be issued by a revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar. In case of no applications being received from PwD sub-category in a particular category, the seat will be de-reserved to its base category.

Candidates must note that the benefits of reservation will be given to them subject to verification of documents. If it is discovered at any stage that a candidate has used a false/fake/incorrect document or has furnished false, incorrect, or incomplete information in order to avail of the benefits of reservation, then such a candidate shall be excluded from the admission process. In case such a candidate has already been given admission, the admission shall stand cancelled.

#### **Notes:**

- i) Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government.
- ii) The SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates of Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate.
- iii) ST certificates from Tamil Nadu state must be issued by the concerned Revenue Divisional Officer.
- iv) If any Certificate is in a language other than English/Hindi, an English version of that certificate attested by a Gazetted Officer/Competent Authority should be uploaded compulsorily, along with scan copy of original certificate as a single PDF file.
- v) Applications which are incomplete/defective/received late, will be rejected summarily and no correspondence will be entertained on such applications. The instructions for online submission of application are available in the online admission portal.

#### **F. List of Documents required for filling out the application:**

- i) Aadhar Card or First Page of Passport or Birth Certificate or Voter ID Card issued by government authorities, as proof of date of birth and Name of Candidate (Note that the name given in the application for ITEP at NIT Calicut should match the name in the supporting document).
- ii) 10th standard / Matriculation or equivalent certificate
- iii) Valid score card of NCET-2025.
- iv) Mark sheet/grade card and Pass certificate (if issued separately from school) of the class XII Board examination (10+2) or its equivalent examination (As single PDF file).
- v) If applicable, OBC-NCL / EWS certificate, obtained from a competent authority (Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar) in the format mentioned above issued on or after 01 April 2025.

vi) If applicable, SC/ST certificate issued by the competent authority (Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar).

vii) If applicable, the PwD Certificate in the specified format along with a Unique Disability Identification (UDID) certificate or Certificate of Disability from a Government Medical Board and should be fit to pursue the Programme. Benefits of PwD reservations would be given only to those with benchmark disability, i.e., not less than 40% impairment, irrespective of the type of disability.

#### **G. Important Points to Note:**

- Applicants are requested to periodically check the NIT Calicut website (<http://nitc.ac.in>) for updates
- Incomplete applications or applications that are not supported by valid documents will be rejected.
- The application fee, once paid will not be refunded.
- The Application Form for admission will not be considered if the fee is not received by NIT Calicut before the application deadline.
- No intimation regarding the rejection of the application form will be sent to the candidates.
- Applicants who fail to accept seats offered at any stage will not be considered further in the admission process.
- All the admissions will be provisional till these are confirmed by the Academic Section of the Institute. If at any stage it is noticed that the candidate has submitted false information / false document, his/her admission will be cancelled and no refund of fee whatsoever will be made.
