Subject: Instructions for viewing of Question Papers and Answer Keys for the Posts of Senior Technician and Technician

1. Question papers for the posts of Senior Technician and Technician conducted during 12th to 13th December 2023 along with their answer keys can be viewed by following the steps below: -
 - (a) Login to <https://dss.nitc.ac.in/nonfacultyrect/login.aspx>
 - (b) Answer keys are indicated by highlighting the correct response in the QP.
 - (c) The access will be active till 10:00 hours of 23 December 2023.
2. Candidates may go through the question papers & answer keys and may raise objection, if any, by paying applicable fee and through the procedure given below.
3. **For payment of fee:** Candidates desirous of raising any objection on the answer key is first required to pay a fee of Rs. 500/- through the UPI ID 9400785524@SBI or alternatively by scanning the QR code given below.

After making the payment, the candidates must send the details of 12-digit transaction ID and also the screen shot of the proof of payment to rectnf@nitc.ac.in. Separate fee is applicable for each objection.

5. **Raising objection:** Candidate has to mention in brief (not more than 150 words) the reason for raising objection against the particular answer key. The supporting files in respect of the question challenged shall be put in a single PDF file and sent to rectnf@nitc.ac.in. This facility is available from 21 December 2023 to 23 December 2023 (up to 10.00 AM). The Challenges will not be accepted through any other medium. While raising the objection, candidate has to mention his/her NITC Roll number and the post to which he/she has attended the exam.

Only candidates who have attended the exam can raise an objection. In case an objection raised by any candidate is sustained, the fee may be reimbursed. It may be noted that the reimbursement procedure may take up to two months.

Candidature is liable to be cancelled for any candidate who raises objection without paying fees or using duplicate bank transaction numbers.

Decision of NIT Calicut on any objection raised by candidates would be final.
