#### Note:

- i) The Medical qualifications possessed by the candidates should have the recognition of the Medical Council of India.
- ii) Completion of compulsory Rotating Internship Certificate, [Registration Certificate, an official document showing name of College / Institution from where degree / diploma has been done and official document showing name of the institution from where experience has been gained are required.]

#### **General Conditions:**

- 1. The applicants are required to apply online mode only. Applicants applying for more than one post are required to apply online separately.
- 2. The age limit and qualifications/experience etc. for the posts shall be determined as on the last date of submission of online application.
- 3. The applicants shall be required to pay a non-refundable application fee of Rs. 1000/- for UR/EWS/OBC category candidates and Rs. 500/- for SC/ST/ESM and PwBD category candidates only through online mode.
- 4. In order to avoid last minute rush, the candidates are advised to apply early enough. The Institute will not be responsible for network problems or any other problem of this nature in submission of online application during last days.
- 5. The essential, desirable qualifications in terms of education and experience for the above post(s), are in accordance with the Recruitment Rules for non-faculty post in NITs as notified by MoE (erstwhile MHRD) in 2019 and adopted by Board of Governors, National Institute of Technology Calicut.
- 4. The Institute reserves the right to cancel and/or alter the number of posts advertised (i.e. increase or decrease the number of vacancies) due to administrative reasons.
- 5. The Institute strives to have a workforce which reflects gender balance and women candidates are encouraged to apply. The Institute follows the reservation norms as per Government of India norms and encourages candidates from all categories to apply.
- 6. As the posts are not reserved for SC/ST/OBC, the age relaxations available to them will not be applicable.
- 7. Relaxation in age to PwD / Ex-Servicemen/Departmental Candidates as per Government of India rules is applicable.
- 8. Regular Staff of NITs will be given relaxation of age etc., as per the provisions stipulated in the Para 4(B)(iii) of MoE (erstwhile MHRD) letter No.F.35-5/2018-TS.III dated 20.02.2019.
- 9. Candidates employed in Govt./Autonomous Bodies/PSUs service should send their applications through proper channel. In case, the original application routed through proper channel is likely to be delayed, an advance copy of the application should be sent, so as to reach before the prescribed last date. All such candidates are required to produce 'No Objection Certificate' at the time of interview.
- 10. Besides the pay in the pay matrix as per the 7th CPC, admissible allowances applicable

for the post like DA, HRA etc. in accordance with Institute Rules in force from time to time are payable. The employees of the Institute will be entitled to medical benefit for self and family as per the relevant rules. New Pension Scheme of Govt. of India is applicable on fresh recruits as per Institute Rules. Accommodation in campus, if available, will be provided on payment of usual license fee. House Rent Allowances will be admissible if accommodation is not provided. Leave Travel Concession for self and family as per Central Government Rules.

- 11. Any Vigilance/Disciplinary cases/Criminal Cases should not be pending/contemplated against the candidates working in any Government Organization. In such cases, application shall not be considered.
- 12. Candidate should not have been convicted by any Court of Law.
- 13. All original documents will have to be produced at the time of selection process/interview for verification.
- 14. No TA/DA will be paid to attend the Written-Test/Skill-Test/Interview.
- 15. The appointment of selected candidates is subject to being found physically fit and sound in health for the services in the Institute which shall be examined through a medical examination by the Medical Board as referred to by the Institute as the case may be.
- 16. No correspondence, whatsoever, will be entertained from the candidates in connection with the process of selection/interview. Canvassing in any manner would entail disqualification of the candidature.
- 17. The applicants are required to visit the Institute website regularly as any subsequent corrigendum/addendum etc. shall be published on the Institute website only.
- 18. The Institute reserves to right to modify/defer or cancel full/part of the advertisement/recruitment at any stage of processing without assigning any reasons.
- 19. The Institute reserves the right not to fill the advertised post.
- 20. The Institute reserves the right to reject any or all applications without assigning any reason.
- 21. The decision of the competent authority will be final in the matter of selection.
- 22. Any dispute regarding the recruitment will fall under the jurisdiction of the High Court of Kerala.

#### **How to apply:**

1. The candidates need to apply online through the link to be notified in the Institute

website: <a href="www.nitc.ac.in">www.nitc.ac.in</a> from 19.02.2024 to 18.03.2024 upto 11:59 p.m. Candidates should click on the online application link, read the instructions carefully and fill-in the online application form giving accurate information. If the online application is not successfully completed, candidate is required to register again. Applications received through any other mode would not be accepted and summarily rejected.

- 2. No request with respect to change in any data entered by the candidate will be entertained once the online application is submitted successfully. While applying online, candidate needs to upload No Objection Certificate, if applicable, the scanned copy of their recent passport size colour photograph & signature. In case the candidate is called for selection process and/or personal interview, he/she will be required to produce his/her original certificate and other relevant documents as mentioned in the on-line application form.
- 3. The hard copy of online application along with self-attested photocopies of all the documents in support of the information given by the candidate in their online application should reach the Registrar, National Institute of Technology, Calicut-673601 (Kerala) by post. Name of the post applied for should be super scribed on the envelope used for sending the hard copy of the application. No manual/paper application will be entertained directly unless registered and applied online. The hard copy of application along with documents must reach the address along with self-attested copy of all documents in support of their age, qualification, experience etc. by 01.04.2024 upto 05.30 p.m.
- 4. It may be noted that a candidate's application only in soft copy will not be entertained and will be rejected summarily if the hard copy of the application form along with other requisite self-attested photocopies of the relevant documents is not received on or before **01.04.2024.**
- 5. Candidates should pay the application fee, as applicable, using the online SBI collect portal. The SBI collect reference number should be furnished in the appropriate field in the online application form. Without payment of fee, application will not be accepted/considered.
- 6. NIT Calicut will not be responsible for any candidate for not being able to submit his/her online application within the last date on account of system error or any other reasons.
