**(Applicable for candidates with a valid GATE/JAM Score)**

National Institute of Technology Calicut (NITC) is conducting an **Institute-level Spot Admissions** for filling the vacant seats of various M. Tech/ M. Plan/M.Sc. programmes on 18<sup>th</sup> August 2025. Candidates with valid GATE/JAM score in respective disciplines have to report as per the schedule given below. **Students who are already admitted to NIT Calicut through CCMT/CCMN are not eligible for the institute Spot round.**

**Eligibility Conditions:** Admissions to M. Tech./M. Plan. through Spot Admission at NIT Calicut will be as per the CCMT 2025 eligibility norms and the special eligibility conditions of NIT Calicut. Admissions to M. Sc. through Spot Admission at NIT Calicut will be as per the CCMN 2025 eligibility norms and the special eligibility conditions of NIT Calicut.

**Registration for Spot Admissions:** The eligible candidates may register for spot admission using the following link. The link will be active between **14<sup>th</sup> August 2025, 05:00 PM and 17<sup>th</sup> August 2025, 05:00 PM**

The candidate should report in person on 18/08/2025 (Monday) between 09.00 am to 10.00 am. Those who report after 10.00 am on 18/08/2025 (Monday) will not be considered for spot admissions.

**Selection Process for M. Tech./M. Plan/M.Sc.:** Vacant seats of M. Tech/M. Plan programmes will be allotted to the eligible candidates based on GATE score (2023/2024/2025) only. Vacant seats of M. Sc. programmes will be allotted to the eligible candidates based on JAM score (2025) only.

**Classes for I Semester M. Tech./M. Plan/M.Sc.:** Admitted candidates have to start attending the regular classes from 19 August 2025 onwards.

**Tentative seat vacancies in each program will be published on the NITC website on 14<sup>th</sup> August 2025.**

## 1. List of Documents to be Produced if seat is allotted at NIT Calicut:

Candidates are required to bring the following documents in original, at the time of admission:

- (a) **Document for Proof of date of birth:** Class X marksheet/ certificate issued by the school last attended/ Recognized educational board containing the date of birth of the applicant. In case, class X marksheet/certificate does not contain date of birth, the candidate is required to upload class X marksheet/ certificate and any other Government issued document containing date of birth of the applicant, name and Parent's name such as Passport/ Aadhar Card/ Driving License/ Voter ID Card/ PAN Card/ Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation/authority empowered to register the birth.
- (b) **Photo ID proof as per Govt. of India norms.**
- (c) Mark sheet of Class XII/ Diploma certificate and mark sheets in case of lateral entry candidates (The candidates who have appeared for improvement has to submit both the original and the improvement mark sheets).
- (d) Grade/Mark sheets of qualifying examination for all semesters / Consolidated Grade (Mark) sheet with all subjects mentioned in it.
  - For the final semester appearing candidates, whose results are awaited or final semester exams are not over, mark sheets up to the pre-final semester need to be produced. If the mark sheets of the final two semesters of the qualifying degree are available as digital copies, the self-attested copies of such certificates are to be produced.
  - The calculation of CGPA or Percentage (Whichever is the primary mode of evaluation criteria by the university) should be clearly visible in the mark sheets / consolidated marks/ grade cards.
- (e.) **Original Degree certificate/ Provisional degree certificate:**
  - **Original degree certificate:** Since the provisional degree certificate is valid for limited period only, candidates who have **graduated in the year 2023 or before** must submit their original degree certificate at the time of physical reporting.
  - **Provisional degree certificate:** Candidates who have graduated in 2024 or 2025 are allowed to submit their provisional degree certificate at the time of physical reporting. However, candidates who have graduated in 2024 have to submit original degree certificate by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025, as stipulated by CCMT/CCMN.
  - **Final semester candidates:** If the result of qualifying degree is awaited, certificate of course completion from the institute/university last studied must be provided in the prescribed format available in **Annexure A**. Such candidates also have to submit an undertaking in the prescribed form as given in **Annexure B**. However, they need to submit provisional degree certificate by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025, as stipulated by CCMT/CCMN.
- (f) GATE score card (2023/2024/2025)/JAM score card (2025)
- (g) Certificate for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS), if applicable, issued by the competent authority (not below the rank of Tahsildar) indicating the financial status for the financial year ending March 31, 2025 (i.e., for the financial year 2025-26) **(this certificate should have been issued on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2025)**. **Candidates, who fail to produce the valid EWS certificate as mentioned above, at the time of admissions, will lose their allotted seat in the category.**

- The financial year shown in the EWS certificate should be 2024-25 and year of validity should be 2025-26.
  - The certificate should contain the office seal along with the signature of the competent authority (Not Applicable for digital certificates).
- (h) Community Certificate, in the case of OBC candidate, from a competent authority (not below the rank of Tahsildar) indicating the status regarding Creamy Layer based on financial year ending March 31, 2025 **(the certificate should have been issued on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2025)**. Candidates, who fail to produce the valid OBC-NCL certificate as mentioned above, at the time of admissions, will lose their allotted seat in the category.
- (i) Community Certificate, in the case of SC/ST candidate, from a competent authority **(not below the rank of Tahsildar)**.
- (j) Certificate from the Medical Board of Govt. Medical Colleges/Dist. Head Quarters Hospitals, in the case of Persons with Disabilities (PwD), if applicable.
- (k) Transfer or Leaving Certificate issued from the institute last studied/attended. You can submit the Migration certificate instead of the Transfer certificate, only if the Institute/University is autonomous/Deemed or the institute is not providing the same. In that case you need to submit a proof issued from the institute last studied/attended stating that they do not issue a transfer certificate.
- (l) Conduct/Character certificate from the Head of the Institution/Organization last attended/working or Gazetted Officer issued within last six months (Should have been issued on or after 1<sup>st</sup> February 2025). If character is indicated in the transfer certificate, please make sure that the Transfer certificate is issued after 1<sup>st</sup> February 2025, otherwise you must produce a separate certificate for character/conduct.**
- (m) Late submission undertaking form (format given in **Annexure-C**), if necessary

This form is applicable only to those candidates graduated in 2023 or 2024. If they do not have the certificates as per the list above, they may submit the undertaking in Annexure C. Note that the undertaking in Annexure C is not applicable for category certificates (OBC-NCL, EWS, SC/ST, PWD certificates).

**Notes:**

1. Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates of Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate. ST certificates from Tamil Nadu state must be issued by the concerned Revenue Divisional Officer.
2. If the original certificates are not in English/Hindi, English/Hindi version/translation of such certificates, duly certified by the Principal/Director or other competent authority of the graduating Institute, will be required during the verification of documents.
3. Candidates, who fail to produce the relevant category certificate (OBC-NCL or EWS certificate, as the case may be) as mentioned above, at the time of physical reporting, will lose their claim for reservation and thus their allotted seat will be cancelled. Please note that the undertaking to be submitted for late submission of relevant documents/ certificates given in Annexure C is not applicable for category certificates.
