The following three items may be removed.

- 1. NITC will make an internal announcement to all the students who are in the top 10% of their class at the end of their 5th semester, with a minimum CGPA of 8.0 and without backlogs/failures, and encourage such students to apply for admission into a Direct Ph.D. program at IITM to those Department(s) in which they meet the eligibility norms for the regular Ph.D. program (subject to availability at IITM), through the online portal between 1st March and 30th March every year:
- 2. NITC will encourage and recommend such students to opt for the summer fellowship of IITM at the end of their 6th semester.
- 3. NITC will forward the list of students who are within the top 10% of their class, with a minimum CGPA of 8.0 and without backlogs/failures, along with their contact details, to the Dean (Academic Research), IITM soon after the 6th-semester results are declared.

The following two items may instead be added, making the conditions identical to the proposed MoU with IITH.

- 1. NITC will make an internal announcement to all students who are in the top 10% of their class in their 6th semester (based on the CGPA calculated until the 5th semester) and encourage such students to apply for admission into a Direct Ph.D. programme at IITH to those Department(s) in which they meet the eligibility norms for regular Ph.D. programme, through online portal between 1st March and 30th March every year.
- 2. NITC also will disseminate the contact details of eligible students to the Dean (Acad), IITH, to enable to Dean to bring the Ph.D. application schedule to these students.
