Agenda Item 1: Ratification of the minutes of the DCC meeting held on 27/09/2022

The DCC ratified the confirmation of the minutes of the DCC meeting dated 27/09/2022.

Agenda Item 2: Action Taken Action Pending Report.

There are no actions pending and no actions to be taken, as per last DCC meeting.

Agenda Item 3: New Slot System

The new slot system was proposed by the Dean Academic to overcome the issues related to classroom availability while dividing the BTech classes into more batches with a class strength of around 50 students per batch. The proposed slot system consists of two slots (first and second slots) for each course for theory sessions. For the first slot, the theory sessions will be in the forenoon (FN) session and lab sessions during the AN (afternoon) session, and the second slot will be having lab sessions during FN and theory sessions in the AN. Three slots have been identified as common institute slots where courses like open electives should be floated. The proposed new slot system was discussed in detail in the DCC meeting. The department exam cell suggested that a single course should run in a single slot (e.g, A1, A2) to the extent possible in order to avoid any further conflicts while scheduling exams. DCC approved the proposed slot system.

- (v) Record of attendance may be made in the biometric system twice a day between 7:30 AM and 9:00 PM, ensuring eight hours of duty in between.
