Gp B&C: Instructions for Viewing of Question Papers & Answer Keys

- 1. Question papers for the four categories of exam conducted during 10th to 13th July 2023 along with their answer keys can be viewed by following the steps below:-
 - (a) Login to https://dss.nitc.ac.in/nonteachingchallenge/login.aspx
 - (b) Answer keys are indicated by circling the correct response in the QP.
 - (c) The access will be active from 5.00 PM on 18 July 23 till 7.00 PM on 20 July 2023.
- 2. Candidates may go through the question papers & answer keys and may raise objection, if any, by paying applicable fee and filling up the requisite form as per procedure given below.
- 3. For payment of fee.
 - (a) Candidates desirous of raising any objection on the answer key is first required to pay a fee of Rs. 500/- through the SBI collect portal by clicking https://www.onlinesbi.sbi/sbicollect/icollecthome.htm. Separate fee is applicable for each objection.
 - (b) Page will be redirected to "Director, National Institute of Technology Calicut".
 - (i) In drop-down list of various payment options, select "Objection fee"
 - (ii) Give your roll no., Name, email id, mobile number and remarks if any
 - (iii) Complete the payment after filling all the details.
 - (iv) Kindly download and keep the receipt (pdf) of the payment ready.
 - (v) The SBI collect link will be available for payment from 11.00 AM on 19th July 2023 to 7.00 PM on 20th July 2023.
- 4. Raising objection: The link for raising objections on the answer keys is: https://dss.nitc.ac.in/nonteachingchallenge/login.aspx
 - (a) You can login into the portal with your email and password. Please make sure that you have paid the requisite fees prior to filling the form.
 - (b) Fill the details like roll no., the category of examination, the question paper series, question no. on which objection is to be raised and fee payment reference number. Candidate is also required to upload the proof of payment of the applicable fees.
 - (c) Candidate has to mention in brief (not more than 150 words) the reason for raising objection against the particular answer key.
 - (d) Only candidates who have attended the exam can raise an objection.
- 5. In case an objection raised by any candidate is sustained, the fee may be reimbursed. Note that the reimbursement procedure may take up to two months.
- 6. Candidature is liable to be cancelled for any candidate who raises objection without paying fees or using duplicate bank transaction numbers.
- 7. Decision of NIT Calicut on any objection raised by candidates would be final.
