Clarifications on Relaxations Applicable and Merit Lists

1. It is reiterated that the list of applicants who have been shortlisted for the selection process as per the notice dated 14 Jun 23 is purely provisional based on data provided by the candidates. Their present eligibility is based on their own claims and the Institute shall undertake detailed verification of documents at a later stage. Hence, their eligibility for further stages of selection process will be subject to satisfactory verification of documents related to various aspects including educational qualifications, age, reservation category etc as well as availability of vacancy for the particular post in their respective category.

2. As per the terms of the advertisement and notification NITC/13-1/2022-RO dated 13 Jul 22, the indicative age relaxations that are available to the applicants:-

(C)	ST	05 years
(d)	ESM ***	03 years over and above the period of service rendered in the Army, Navy or Air Force.
(e)	PwD ***	PwD General- 10 yearsPwD SC/ST- 15 yearsPwD OBC- 13 yearsSubject to the maximum age on crucial date not exceeding 56 years
(f)	Regular staff of NITs appointed before the date of implementation of RRs in NITs including model RRs (2012)	
(g)	Personnel who served in NIT Calicut as adhoc/ temporary/ contractual/ outsource basis within 15 years from 20.02.2019 (i.e. during the period 21.02.2004 to 20.02.2019)	

******* In case of variations, relaxations as per GoI orders in vogue are applicable

3. Applicants availing age relaxations as per para 2(g) above may note that the maximum permissible age relaxation is 15 years irrespective of their reservation category.

4. Applicants availing age relaxation as per para 2(f) or 2(g) above will be considered in UR and their specific reservation category. This is as per DoPT order which states that a candidate belonging to SC/ST/OBC etc who is selected on the same standard as applied to general candidates and who appears in the general merit list is treated as own merit candidate.

5. Applicants of other reservation categories shall be considered in their respective reservation categories if any relaxation has been availed. This is as per DoPT orders on the subject wherein it is brought out that, when a relaxed standard is applied in selecting an SC/ST/OBC etc candidate, for example in age limit, experience, qualification etc, the SC/ST/OBC etc candidates are to be counted against reserved vacancies. Such candidates would not be eligible for consideration against unreserved vacancies.

6. While drawing up rank list/ merit lists, the post and reservation category shall be considered. Separate post wise- reservation category wise rank lists shall be drawn as per the post wise distribution of vacancies published on the Institute website.

7. Applicants for the selection process are advised to verify availability of vacancy for their claimed reservation category in the post-wise distribution of vacancies published on the Institute website. Any candidate may request for withdrawal of candidature and seek refund of fees paid provided:-

- (a) Candidate belongs to reserved category, and
- (b) No vacancy available for specific category under a particular post, and
- (c) Application fees has been paid, and
- (d) Candidate Not eligible to be considered under UR category

8. The candidates requesting for withdrawal of application as per para 7 above may seek refund of the application fees by writing to rectnf@nitc.ac.in along with documentary proof and bank details. Such request for withdrawal and refund should be made on or before 05 July 23. It may also be noted that the refund process may take three to four months, if eligible.
