- 4) Candidates who are employed in Central Government/PSUs/ Government autonomous institutions/ Central and State Govt. undertakings in regular basis will be required to submit a No-Objection-Certificate. Such candidates will NOT be permitted to appear for the Interview without NOC.
- 5) Candidates not in possession of requisite essential experience as per the Recruitment Rules will be rejected and not permitted to appear for the Interview.

General Instructions for all the Candidates coming for the Selection Process

- Verification of original documents will be undertaken during / after initial screening tests and prior to the interview. Candidates are to produce all original documents and a self-attested photocopies of the same. The photocopies shall be retained by the Institute.
- 2. Screening test may be conducted if more candidates are appearing for the selection process. Presentation (15 Slides, 10 Minutes) on how candidate's experience would help the Institute over the next 3-5 years may need to presented during the Interview.
- 3. Candidates while appearing for the selection process should bring all the following relevant certificates and testimonials in original along with a set of self-attested photocopies.
 - a. 10th standard and 10+2 Mark sheets in original
 - b. Semester wise mark sheets of UG/PG Degree in original (CGPA/DGPA equivalency certificate, wherever applicable)

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- c. UG/PG Degree certificates in original
- d. Proof of Age
- e. ID Proof with photo (Aadhaar Card/ Passport / Voter ID)
- f. Original documents in support of all credentials, claimed in the application.
- g. Experience/Service certificates and Last Pay/Salary drawn certificate from the Institutes/Organizations (wherever applicable and if claimed in the application).
- h. Candidates currently employed in Government/Semi-Government/Govt. Autonomous Organization/Institute, are required to produce 'No Objection Certificate' from their present employer at the time of verification of original documents.
- i. All the candidates should bring letter(s) of reference/testimonial from two people under whom they have worked or a Group A officer or equivalent under GoI known to them. The details of the referee especially the contact details like e-mail and phone number must be clearly mentioned in the letters.
- j. SC, ST, OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/EWS candidates should bring a valid original community certificate as per central list issued by competent authority. OBC (Non-creamy layer)/Income and Asset Certificate for EWS should be obtained on or after 01/04/2022 to be considered in that category.
- k. Person with Disability (PwD) candidates should produce medical certificate obtained from Medical Board concerned including the percentage of their infirmity. Only those with percentage of disability above the minimum specified by Government of India shall only be eligible for the benefit of reservation.
- I. Self-attested copy of online application with recent passport size photo affixed, copy of the fee challan (or proof of fee payment made) and this call letter in Original
- 4. Candidates will have to appear for the selection process at their own cost. No TA/DA shall be paid to attend the selection process.
- 5. Request for change of date, venue, time, etc., shall not be entertained for any candidate.
- 6. Requests for accommodation in the Institute while coming for the selection process will not be entertained.
- 7. Appearing for the selection process / interview will not, in any way, ensure any right to be selected. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
