Emergency DCC Meeting for consideration of the Starting of Offline Classes and Campus Return of MCA Students

The DCC meeting started online at 12:20 PM. The Chairperson welcomed all members to the meeting.

The DCC, CSED discussed the campus return plan for MCA students and resolved to recommend the following to Dean Academic:

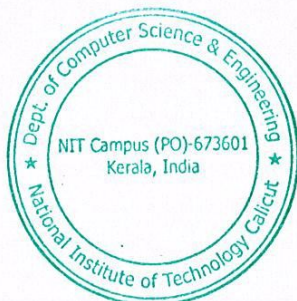
1. First Year MCA students may be directed to return to the campus during the period March 16 - March 20, 2022, as was proposed by the Chief Warden. The classes, which are scheduled to start on the coming Monday (21st February), shall proceed online till March 15. There may be non-instructional days on March 16, 17 to facilitate campus joining.

Offline classes shall resume from March 21st. Since the MID I examination for MCA is scheduled to start on March 25, all their evaluations shall be offline. It is proposed that the course plan may be prepared as per standard procedures of offline classes and evaluations with the corresponding weightages of mid and final exams.

All first year MCA students may be allowed to stay in the campus till June 15.

2. Classes and evaluations for Second year MCA students may continue online, as they share elective courses with S6 B.Tech and S8 B.Tech. Hence, they may not be directed to return to the campus.
3. All evaluations of final year MCA students will be conducted online. However, any student who wishes to return to the campus for her/his project work may be permitted, provided the hostel office is able to accommodate the request.
4. All second and final year MCA students who have backlog subjects to be credited in the first year may be permitted to rejoin the campus. (All higher semester B.Tech students who have backlog fourth semester subjects may also be permitted to rejoin the campus).
