


The DCC discussed the requests from the repeating students regarding floating the odd semester courses 'CS3001 Theory of Computation' and 'CSU491 Seminar' in the even semester. As per the curriculum CS3001 and CSU491 are offered in the 5th and 7th semesters respectively. In the case of a student failing, the present regulation does not forbid the student from crediting the same course in any later semester including even semesters. As there is a considerable number of repeaters requesting for the course, the DCC looked into the matter considering the regulations in force and resolved to recommend in favour of offering the course, subject to the approval of the competent authority. The DCC also observed that none of the students are violating the credit requirement in the regulation even when they are allowed to take this course. Moreover the department felt that several students might be able to save a year and sit for placement by using this provision. Three of the repeaters requesting for the course have reached the six year limit. In view of the interest of students, department decided to offer the course, subject to permission from the BOAC and the Senate. Hence the requests are recommended and forwarded for the consideration of the BOAC and the Senate.

2. DCC considered the request of Mr. S Ranjith Nayak (B090923CS) ,who has completed 6 years of study and completed 158/175 credits, to register for odd semester course CSU498 project during the Winter semester. The student will not have credit overload as he has only 14 credits to register now excluding 3 credit project. If he is not permitted he will be requesting a contact course. As the student has maximum duration of the course (6 years) and as the guide has recommended the same and regulations do not prohibit an odd semester course being offered in the even semester, DCC recommends and forwards the request for the permission of BOAC and Senate.

3. DCC resolved to recommend that the Adhoc appointments of faculty and staff may be done for a period of one year instead of the current practice of 6 months. DCC observed that the inter-semester break being very short, many of the department level activities are adversely affected by the termination of the adhoc faculty and staff at the end of the odd semester.
