Minutes of DCC Meeting held on 31-December-2013 in CSED Seminar Hall at 11.15 am

- 1. DCC discussed the query from the academic section regarding the registration of S5 students for MCA Seminar (CSM581) course. The DCC observed that according to the MCA 2011 curriculum, "In addition to the electives listed in the curriculum, a student may be permitted to credit as an elective any other course offered in the institute, subject to consent from the Faculty Advisor" (Ref: http://cse.nitc.ac.in/sites/default/files/programs/curriculum/mca_curriculum_2011.pdf)
 The Faculty advisor for S5 MCA, Dr Sudeep, and several faculty opined that crediting CS4098 Seminar contributed to the student's communication skills and employability. Hence The DCC recommended that the students may be permitted to credit this course as an additional elective to their prescribed courses. However the DCC observed that in the DSS entry the course is incorrectly marked as a core, and the entry needs to be corrected as an elective course. The DCC entrusted Dr.Sudeep. K.S, Faculty Advisor to take the necessary follow-up in this matter.
- 2. The DCC discussed the oral complaint received by the class committee chairperson for the first class committee of eighth semester B. Tech, Mr Vinod Pathari, from students regarding the conduct of First Mid Semester Test for the elective course- Advanced Computer Networks. The students had reported that the questions given for the exam were repeated from the previous semester's exam questions. The DCC requested for a clarification from the course faculty Mr. Sreenu Naik Bhukya, and he reported that the questions were only partly repeated, not completely, and it happened because he was not in station at the time of exams. The HOD requested all the faculty to strictly follow the norms and standards traditionally followed in the institute regarding the conduct of classes, examinations and recording attendance, in the interest of the department and the institute.
- 3. The DCC approved the requests from 17, 6th semester MCA students for doing their final semester projects outside NITC .
- 4. Dr.S.D Madhu Kumar, HoD informed all the members that the CSEA is planning a batch get together for the 2008 pass out batch of CSE grandaunts. The two day event 'REVOIR'14 is scheduled for 21st and 22nd of March 2014.
