Minutes of the DCC Meeting on 4th September 2018 (Tuesday)

Venue: APJ Abdul Kalam Conference Hall, CSED

Time: 12.20 pm - 12.45 pm

The meeting started at 12.30 pm. Dr. Saleena N, HoD, CSED welcomed the members to the DCC meeting. The DCC discussed the suggestion proposed in the meeting of the Deans and HoDs to modify the method of calculating the marks for continuous assessment. The suggestion was that a weighted average of the marks of the Test - I and Test - II series can be considered for the internal marks, with the best among the two having 75% weightage and the lower one having 25% weightage.

DCC made the following observations about this suggestion:

- DCC observed that the proposed scheme does not work well with the spirit of continuous evaluation.
- DCC felt that the proposed system can lead to degradation of academic quality.
- The DCC commented on the lack of clarity regarding the requirement for such a proposal.

Hence, the DCC decided **not to recommend** the proposal. However, DCC has no objection to the idea of implementing the scheme in courses where absolute grading is being followed, like First year B. Tech courses.
