**Amendments to 2023 B.Tech. ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS  
(As per the decision of the 104th Meeting of the Senate)**

As per the decision of the 104th meeting of the Senate, the following clauses of the Ordinances and Regulations of the B. Tech. programme (applicable to 2023 admission onwards) are amended as given below:

**R7.2 Registration and Enrollment (amended)**

*B.Tech. students can register for the normal prescribed credit load of the semester (except during the eighth semester), as specified in the curriculum, plus one additional core or elective course, subject to the following conditions:*

- *Students repeating failed courses or crediting dropped courses, along with regular courses, are permitted to overload by one additional core or elective course beyond the normal credit load of the semester.*
- *For all other students, the overload course must be an elective.*
- *Students who are only repeating or crediting dropped courses, as well as students in the eighth semester, will be permitted to register for a maximum of 24 credits in that semester.*
- *Students enrolled in a minor programme will be permitted to register for one additional course, in addition to the permitted overload, during semesters 4 to 7, specifically for the purpose of fulfilling the minor programme requirements.*

*Note: B.Tech. students are required to register for eight semesters (four years) by paying the applicable Semester fee, so as to become eligible for the award of B. Tech degree as per R9 and R25.*

**As per the decision of the 104th meeting of the Senate, the following clauses of the Ordinances and Regulations of the B. Tech. programme (applicable to 2023 admission onwards) are amended as given below:**

**R.18 Re-examination**

As per the decision of the 104th meeting of the Senate, the following clauses of the Ordinances and Regulations of the B. Arch. programme (applicable to 2023 admission onwards) are amended as given below:

**R.18 Re-examination**

**R18.2 (amended):** *In case a student gets F grade in REX of a core theory course, it is not mandatory for him/her to repeat the course. Instead, the student will be permitted to write the REX again in the next session (when the course is offered) without repeating the course, if he/she desires to do so. If the failed course happens to be an elective course, an alternative elective course can be chosen or the course can be repeated, when it is offered. Students are permitted to appear for the REX of the failed core theory course till he/she gets a PASS grade subject to conditions stipulated in R.8. The maximum grade that can be obtained by a student, when he/she clears the core theory course through REX is E. The above option is available only for those students who keep their registration live by paying the applicable Semester fee.*

*A student who earns an F grade in Architectural Design course in the Monsoon or Winter semester after appearing for the end-semester jury examination can apply for Architectural Design Re-Examination (ADREX) during the succeeding summer vacation.*

As per the decision of the 104th meeting of the Senate, the following clauses of the Ordinances and Regulations of the B. Tech./B. Arch. programme (applicable to 2019 admission onwards) are amended as given below:

**R.21 Re-examination**

*R.21.4 (amended for 2022 and previous admissions): In case a student gets F grade in a core theory course, it is not mandatory for him/her to repeat the course. Instead, the student will be permitted to write the REX in the next session (when the course is offered) without repeating the course, if he/she desires to do so. If the failed course happens to be an elective course, an alternative elective course can be chosen or the course can be repeated when it is offered. Students are permitted to appear for the REX of the failed core theory course (for 100 marks) till he/she gets a PASS grade subject to conditions stipulated in R.8. The maximum grade that can be obtained by a student, when he/she clears the core course through REX is E. The above option is available only for those students who keep their registration live by paying the Semester fee.*
