Instructions to Candidates

The candidates who got their final allotment to National Institute of Technology Calicut, through DASA scheme coordinated by NIT Warangal for the academic year 2022-23 have to physically report for taking admissions. All candidates who got seat allotment in various Departments/ Schools of NIT Calicut mentioned below are requested to physically report and take admissions (Subject to fulfilling of eligibility requirements and verification of original documents as per the guidelines given in PG DASA brochure) according to the schedules given below.

The venue for reporting is BHASKARA HALL, NIT CALICUT

Date & Time for Physical Reporting @ NIT Calicut⁻ 20th August 2022 @ 9am

Orientation & Commencement of classes: 23 August 2022

Hostel admissions will also happen on the same day

1. <u>List of Documents to be Produced at the time of Physical Reporting to the Institute:</u>

Candidates are required to bring the following documents in original, at the time of Physical reporting:

- (a) Applicant's Passport (Nationals of Nepal who do not have a passport, copy of Authenticated Citizenship Card has to be submitted) and PIO/OCI card as applicable.
- (b) Provisional admission letter.
- (c) Document for Proof of date of birth: Secondary Education Board / University Certificate [Class X or equivalent] or any certificate issued by the Government authorities.
- (d) Photo ID proof as per Govt. of India norms.
- (e) Proof for residential eligibility requirement for Indian Nationals who have completed their undergraduate degree from India, as applicable Proof for having acquired NRI status and holding it for the last three years after obtaining undergraduate degree from India/ Proof for having completed undergraduate degree in any CFTI under the DASA Scheme (Certificate from Institution)/ Proof having completed 11th and 12th standard (or equivalent) from outside India (Certificate from School authorities).
- (f) Details and proof of fee payment in case of payment by SWIFT transfer.

- (g) GRE/GMAT Score card.
- (h) Mark sheet of Class XII/ Diploma certificate and mark sheets in case of lateral entry candidates (The candidates who have appeared for improvement has to submit both the original and the improvement mark sheets).
- (i) Grade/Mark sheets of qualifying examination for all semesters / Consolidated Grade (Mark) sheet with all subjects mentioned in it.
 - For the final semester appearing candidates, whose results are awaited or final semester exams are not over, mark sheets up to the pre-final semester need to be produced. If the mark sheets of the final two semesters of the qualifying degree are available as digital copies, the self-attested copies of such certificates are to be produced.
 - The calculation of CGPA or Percentage (Whichever is the primary mode of evaluation criteria by the university) should be clearly visible in the mark sheets / consolidated marks/ grade cards.

(e.) Original Degree certificate/ Provisional degree certificate:

- Original degree certificate: Since the provisional degree certificate is valid for limited period only, candidates who have passed out in the year 2020 or before must submit their original degree certificate at the time of physical reporting.
- Provisional degree certificate: Candidates who have graduated in 2021 or 2022 are allowed to submit their provisional degree certificate at the time of physical reporting. However, candidates who have graduated in 2021 have to submit original degree certificate by 30th September 2022.
- (f) Final semester candidates: If the result of qualifying degree is awaited, certificate of course completion from the institute/university last studied must be provided in the prescribed format available in Annexure A. Such candidates also have to submit an undertaking in the prescribed form as given in Annexure B. However, they need to submit provisional degree certificate by 30th September 2022.
- (g) Transfer or Leaving Certificate issued from the institute last studied/attended. You can submit the Migration certificate instead of the Transfer certificate, only if the Institute/University is autonomous/Deemed or the institute is not providing the same. In that case you need to submit a proof issued from the institute last studied/attended stating that they do not issue a transfer certificate.
- (h) Conduct/Character certificate from the Head of the Institution/Organization last attended/working or Gazetted Officer issued within last six months (Should have been issued on or after 1st February 2022). If character is indicated in the transfer certificate, please make sure that the Transfer certificate is issued after 1st February 2022, otherwise you must produce a separate certificate for character/conduct.
- (i) Other documents as uploaded during registration.
- (j) Late submission undertaking form (format given in Annexure-C), if necessary
- (k) One Photostat copy of all relevant original documents also should be submitted at the time of Physical reporting.

Notes:

- 1. If the original certificates are not in English/Hindi, English/Hindi version/translation of such certificates, duly certified by the Principal/Director or other competent authority of the graduating Institute, will be required during the verification of documents.

4. Details of Fee (Other than Hostel Fee) to be Paid at the Time of Admissions

At the time of physical reporting, candidates will be required to pay Rs 47,005/- to NIT Calicut

(This amount does not include Tuition fee, which has to be Paid to DASA).

Payment has to be made through **State Bank Collect** (online) using **Net Banking / Credit Card / SBI Challan (by cash) after the seat allotment process. Necessary arrangements for the above payment process will be made in Bhaskara Hall.**

Please note that if you are using any other mode for fee payment (Debit Card, Paytm etc.) other than those specified above, the fee will not be credited to our account.

5. Hostel Facility:

Hostel facilities are available for all the students. Hostel Room Allotment will be done to the admitted students at the time of physical reporting at the Institute and after payment of the requiredhostel fees. Fee structure for the hostel accommodation is available in the following link:

6. Refund Rules:

Refund of fee shall be permitted to a student who leaves the academic programme till such dates that will permit the Institute to fill the vacancy so created through subsequent seat allotment process of the Institute. In such cases, all fee and deposits paid at the time of admission will be refunded after a deduction of processing fee of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one Thousand only). No fee other than Caution Deposit shall be refunded to students who withdraw admission after such stipulated dates.

Only primary mode of evaluation (CGPA or percentage) as mentioned in the qualifying degree certificate/mark sheet shall be considered while verifying eligibility. Conversion from CGPA to percentage or vice versa given by individual Institute/university will not be allowed"

4. I am also aware that after the announcement of my Bachelor's degree results, if I am found not to satisfy the above eligibility criteria, my admission would be cancelled and I will not be entitled for refund of the Institute fee paid to CCMT.
