The Secretary welcomed the members present to the 97th meeting of the Senate of the National Institute of Technology Calicut and the Chairman called the meeting to order at 3.30 PM.

S97.1: Special permission requests from higher semester UG students for continuing the program of study

Background:

As per the Ordinances and Regulations for B. Tech and B. Arch programmes (Applicable to 2019 Admission Onwards), there is a minimum requirement to continue the programme, which is given below.

R8.1 Minimum Requirement to Continue the Programme

A student admitted to B Tech/B Arch programme in the first semester can continue up to 8th/10th semester, in the ascending order, subject to the conditions that he/she shall become eligible for registration to (i) 3rd semester, only on earning 15 credits, (ii) 5th semester, only on earning 40 credits, (iii) 7th semester, only on crediting all 1st level courses and earning 65/70 credits as per the relevant curriculum and (iv) 9th semester, only on crediting all 1st and 2nd level courses and earning 90 credits for B Arch as per the relevant curriculum.

When a student fails to satisfy the above mentioned stipulations at any stage, he/she has to discontinue the programme and leave the Institute. The credit requirements mentioned above do not include OT courses, which are Pass/Fail courses and are not considered for CGPA calculation.

Requests were received from many UG students who didn't meet the minimum requirement to continue the programme as given below.

- a) *The following B.Tech students have secured more than 65 credits as per the relevant curriculum to register for 7th semester, but they have at least one first level backlog course.*

Decision: The Senate discussed the agenda item in detail and decided the following.

a) For UG students who have secured more than 65 credits as per the relevant curriculum to register for the 7th semester, but have at least one first-level backlog course, the following guidelines shall be followed:

- All the higher semester UG students, who have acquired the required number of credits to register for the 7th semester, but have first level backlog courses will be permitted to register for the Monsoon and Winter semesters 2024 - 2025.
- These students have to register for all the first level backlog courses available in the respective semester and then for the lower level backlog courses, if any, available in the respective semester as per the B. Tech./B. Arch. regulations.

- They are allowed to register for the 7th/8th semester courses provided the total credits registered in the respective semester is not more than the normal allowable credit limit of the semester as per the regulations. Faculty Advisors shall monitor the progression of these students on a regular basis.

b) For UG students who have not secured enough credits as per the relevant curriculum to register for the 7th or 5th semester

- All the higher semester UG students who do not satisfy the minimum credit requirements for enrollment in the 5th or 7th semester shall be permitted to register for the Monsoon and Winter semesters of the academic year 2024 - 2025.
- Such students have to register for lower level backlog courses available in the current semester as per the regulations.
- They will be allowed to register for higher semester courses (i.e., courses that do not have prerequisite) only if the cumulative credits of the backlog courses to be registered in the corresponding semester are below the normal allowed credit limit set forth in the curriculum for that semester.
- Such students are permitted to register for a maximum of six theory courses each during both the Monsoon and Winter semesters 2024 - '25. Faculty Advisors shall monitor the progression of these students on a regular basis.

Further, the Senate decided to extend these provisions to all the students who have credit shortage or first level backlog courses to register for Monsoon and Winter semesters 2024-'25. The Senate authorized the Dean (Academic) to approve similar cases of registration to Monsoon and Winter semesters 2024-'25. It was also decided that these provisions are to be considered as a one-time relaxation.

S97.2. Ratification of the permission granted by the Chairman Senate to students to complete the program by crediting one course in contact mode

Background:

Few students have one course short for meeting the credit requirement for the successful completion of their programme. The students have requested to offer the necessary course in contact mode to meet the credit requirement. The details of the students who have requested the contact course are provided below.
